修满 24 个含核心课程的幼儿教育学分，包括：

- 3 个儿童成长与发展课程学分
- 3 个幼儿教育课程导论
- 3 个儿童、家庭与社区课程学分
- 3 个面向儿童教育与督导工作者的幼儿教育选修课学分

以及 16 个通识教育课程学分

**选项 2：**

持有 CTC 颁发的有效教师执照

自 2026-2027 起，所有学术学分必须来自经 CTC 批准的区域认证机构。

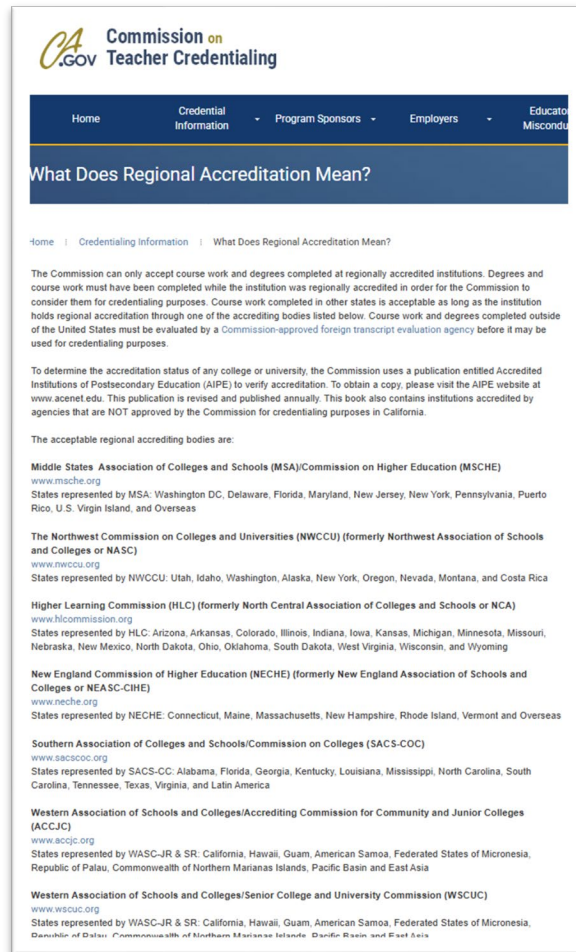

步骤 2: 向下滚动查找您完成课程学习和/或获得学位的州份。请注意，相同的州可能会出现多个委员会组织下，这取决于您的院校是学院还是大学。

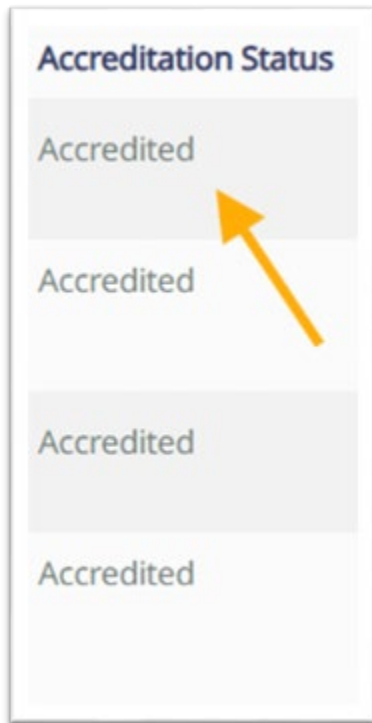

An agency may submit a written request to the Commission to be added to the list of Commission approved foreign transcript evaluating agencies. An evaluating agency must be a current member of either the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) or the Association of International Credential Evaluators, Inc. (AICE).
